Subject: Monthly Activity Report – February, 2007

Operations:

Emergency Incident Responses:

On February 15, at 10:03 P.M., fire crews responded to a reported structure fire on Del Ciervo Road. Upon arrival at the residence, firefighters discovered that the inside of the chimney was on fire. The flames were quickly extinguished and contained to the interior of the chimney. The cause of the fire was determined to be lack of maintenance and cleanliness of the chimney. There was no damage as a result of this fire.

On February 16, at 6:47 P.M., fire crews responded to an alarm sounding on Del Ciervo Road at the same residence as the day before. Upon arrival firefighters discovered the house filled with smoke. The smoke was coming from the oven in the kitchen of the residence. A pan of sugar was burning inside the oven when the oven door was opened. When they returned the engine company was at scene ventilating the house. The owners of the house explained that they were caramelizing sugar and went to a friend's house to swim. There was no damage as a result of this fire.

On February 16, at 10:43 P.M., fire crews responded to a reported refuse fire on Viscaino Road. Upon arrival fire crews discovered a dumpster can on fire. After extinguishment and further investigation, firefighters saw that someone had stuffed an ignited road flare inside the can and had put pine needles and branches around it. The fire investigator was dispatched to the scene. There were no injuries from this fire, but the cost of the melted trash dumpster was approximately \$65.

On March 12, crews were dispatched to a report of a riding lawn mower over the cliff's edge on the 7th hole at the Pebble Beach Golf Links. A maintenance worker had driven the mower over the edge, and landed at the water's edge, approximately 30-40 feet below. Crews performed a low angle rescue of the victim, who was transported to the Valley Medical Center in Santa Clara County by CAL STAR air ambulance. (The fire department has prepared a short Power Point presentation to show the board and audience).

Apparatus and Equipment:

All district equipment is in service.

Training:

Emergency Medical System Continuing Education Drills:

Personnel were scheduled to review Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) curriculum skills and complete written tests to obtain continuing education units (CEU's). EMT's are required to complete 24 hours of CEU's every two years to keep their EMT certification current.

Engine and Truck Company Drills:

All companies were scheduled to perform in service training in their respective response areas in order to maintain Engine and Truck Company Performance Standards.

Aerial Apparatus Driver Operator Training:

A five day in-house Aerial Apparatus Driver Operator class was held at the Pebble Beach Fire Station. It was attended by three Fire Captains, three Fire Apparatus Engineers and two Firefighter II's.

Fire Prevention:

General Information:

The first few days of February, staff and Monterey County Planning and Building officials completed structural inspections of temporary structures erected for the AT&T National Pro-Am. Additional inspections of tents, kitchens, and storage facilities were conducted by prevention bureau staff through the remainder of the event.

During the AT&T, Chief Carreiro and Fire Captain Jones stood by for over-crowding conditions at both The Lodge and the Inn at Spanish Bay. There was one incident that required Fire Department intervention to reduce the occupancy load at the Tap Room.

On February 21st, Chief Carreiro met with Monterey County Office of Emergency Services staff and members of the Pebble Beach Company to discuss the Pebble Beach portion of the county-wide Tsunami Response Plan. This was expected to be the final review of the county plan prior to being submitted for approval. One area of concern that was identified was a possible problem with radio communications between the Fire Department and PB Security. Chief Carreiro will be meeting with members of the PB Company to explore options and solutions.

Fire Defense:

As reported at the February Board meeting, work is scheduled to begin on the fuel break and maintenance on the land directly behind the Sunridge Pines/Pine

Meadows neighborhood on April 9th. Gabilan Fire Crews are scheduling two crews (17 crewmembers each) per day for two weeks. PBCSD is the sponsor for this project.

On March 1st, Chiefs Haines and Carreiro, Directors Verbenac and Verhasselt along with several residents of Sunset Drive met and walked the area above Pescadero Canyon and Fire Road 23.

Some of the areas of concern that were discussed were:

- Interpretations of “allowable vegetation within the 100’ zone” from a residence. *The inspectors will spend more time educating property owners of each parcel in order to better educate them about flammable vegetation and how to correctly build in “defensible space” on their property.*
- The Pescadero Canyon fuel reduction zone of 100 feet below property lines is not being consistently enforced. *The Fire Chief agrees, and will work more closely with the crews to ensure compliance.*
- The need for additional signage at fire road intersections. *The Fire Chief agrees, and will work with the PB Company to add signs.*
- What is acceptable “canopy percentage”? Are we meeting the sixty percent goal as outlined in the Fire Defense Plan? *Chief Carreiro and Forester Bray will be addressing the effectiveness of the current canopy percentage along Fire Road 23 and if needed, will work with the landowners and Pebble Beach Company to bring this into compliance.*

Contact has already been made with Pebble Beach Company to discuss their maintenance plans for the year. Some of the work on Pebble Beach Company land may be completed while Fire Crews are assigned to the Sunridge Pines/Pine Meadows Fuel Break project.

Public Education and Training:

On February 23, Fire Captain Jones conducted CPR and Automated External Defibrillator (AED) training to 11 residents.

Plan Review and Inspections:

- 14 Sets of plans were received for review this month
- 8 Sets of plans were finalized this month
- 15 On site inspections were completed this reporting period.
This includes construction, alarm, sprinkler or final inspections.
