### Operation:

#### Emergency Incident Responses:

On September 16, firefighters responded to a reported vehicle fire on Congress Road. Upon arrival firefighters discovered a vehicle fully engulfed in fire. Vegetation around the vehicle was also on fire. No injuries were reported. Damage is estimated at \$12,000. The fire start is attributed to the vehicle striking a tree and landing in the vegetation. Heat from the muffler ignited the vegetation.

On September 23, firefighters responded to a reported wildland fire on Sunridge Road. Upon arrival firefighters discovered a fire on a trail near the road. The fire was contained to less than ¼ acre. No damage or injuries reported. The fire cause is under investigation.

On September 25, firefighters responded to a reported wildland fire on Congress Road. Upon arrival firefighters discovered a fire between Fire Road #1 and Fire Road #2. The fire was contained to ½ acre. No damage or injuries reported. The fire cause is under investigation.

Other incident responses are listed on the Monthly Response Activity Report.

#### Apparatus and Equipment:

All district apparatus are in service.

### Training:

In September firefighters participated in the following training drills or sessions:

- **Emergency Medical Services (EMS)**  
Fire personnel trained on the importance of wearing protective equipment to prevent exposure to contamination during patient assessment and treatment.
- **Physical Fitness**  
Firefighters reviewed the factors leading to good physical fitness. The review included ways to increase endurance, muscular strength and setting personal fitness goals.
- **Safety**  
Firefighters reviewed and discussed different case history reports that involved a firefighter fatality or injury. Emphasis was placed on habits or work techniques that can be changed to improve firefighter safety.

Fire Prevention:

General Information:

FC Jones was assigned to the Day Fire in Los Angeles and Ventura Counties as a Food Unit Leader.

Staff participated in numerous facility inspections for the First Tee Open.

Chief Carreiro has been representing the Monterey County fire departments in re-writing the "Safety Element" of the General Plan. The committee anticipates submitting their final document to the Planning Commission by the end of October.

Fire Defense:

Residential Fire Inspections are continuing. More than 925 inspections have been completed to date.

Vacant Lot inspections are continuing. Bids are being solicited for having clearance work completed on 14 parcels.

Public Education and Training:

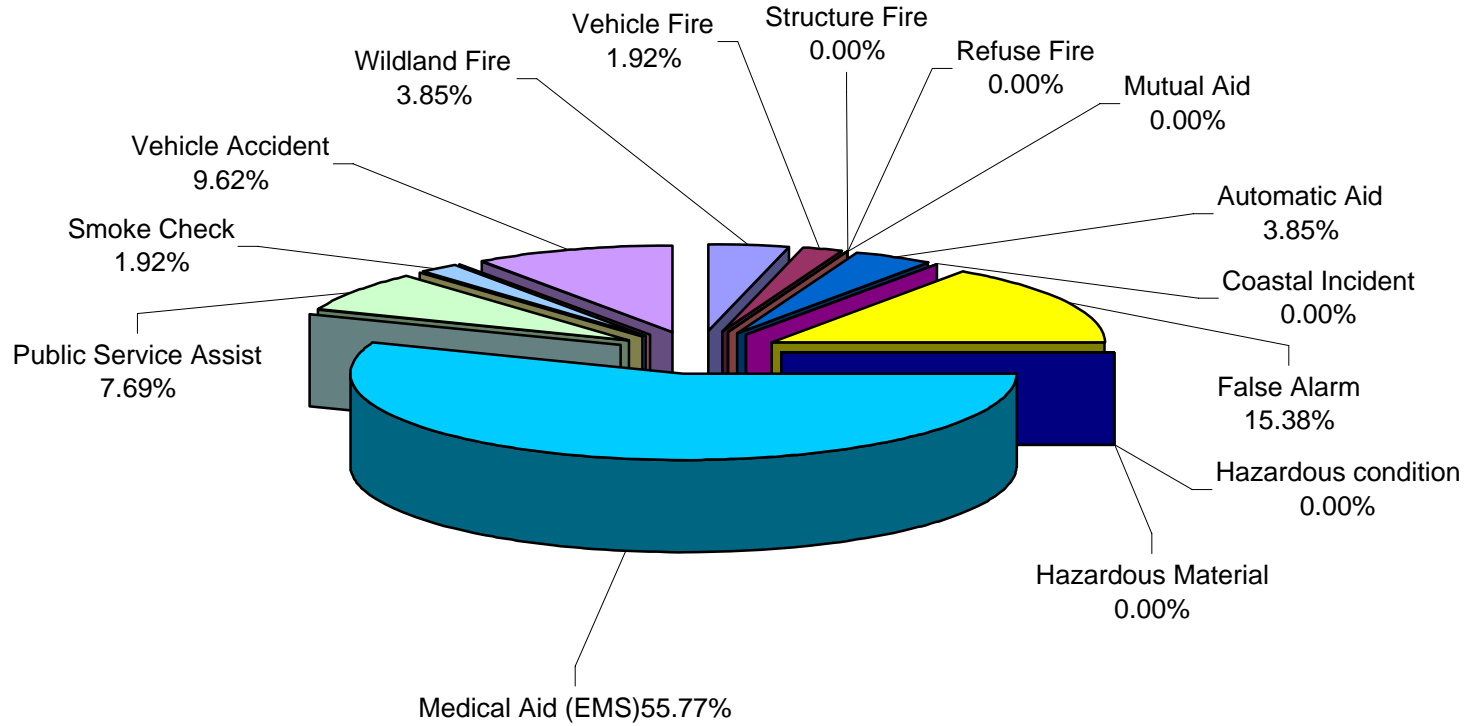
FC Jones taught a citizen CPR class for nine residents.

Plan Review and Inspections:

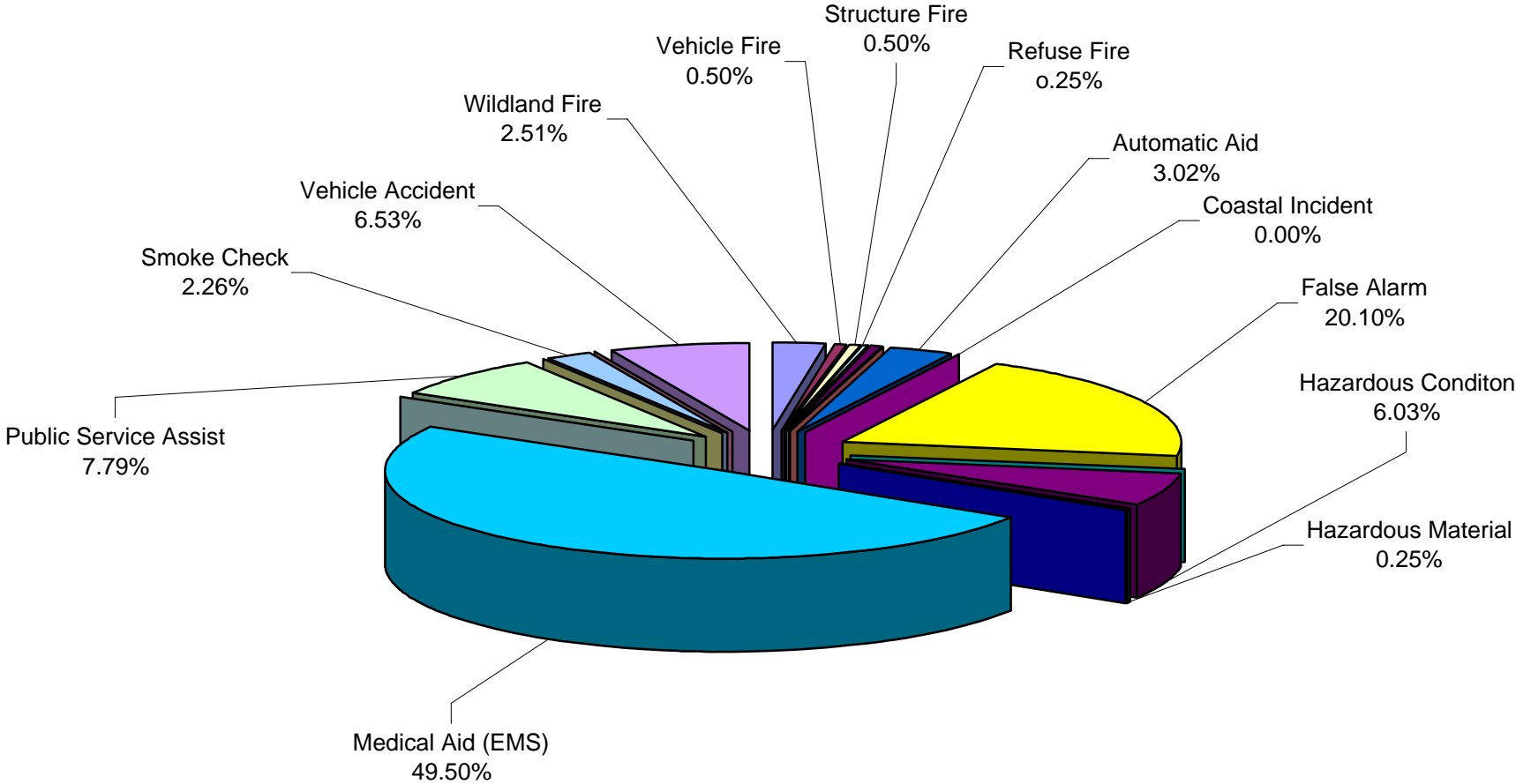
The following inspections and plan checks were completed during this reporting period:
