Subject: Surplus & Donation of Ladder Truck T122

RECOMMENDATION

Adopt *Resolution 24-35* declaring reserve ladder truck T122 surplus and authorize donation of ladder truck T122 to the South Bay Regional Fire Training Consortium.

DISCUSSION

With the recent delivery of the new frontline Ladder Truck T22, our 2004 American LaFrance reserve Ladder Truck T122 has reached the end of its service life as a response resource. This truck is still in good condition and would be a great asset for the South Bay Regional Fire Training Consortium, as their current fleet is reaching a state of disrepair. The PBCSD logo could remain with a decal that reads "Donated by" over the top and "Training" in the white reflective stripe. This would allow the students to see the agency that is supporting the first step in their career.

**DECLARING RESERVE LADDER TRUCK T122 SURPLUS AND
AUTHORIZE DONATION OF LADDER TRUCK T122 TO THE
SOUTH BAY REGIONAL FIRE TRAINING CONSORTIUM**

WHEREAS, the Pebble Beach Community Services District (District) has an ongoing program to purchase and replace capital equipment. A frontline ladder truck shall serve a ten-year period before being moved into reserve status, where it will serve another ten years, for a total service life of twenty years, and;

WHEREAS, the District took delivery of a new 2024 Pierce ladder truck in October 2024 to replace the existing frontline ladder truck and;

WHEREAS, after ten years of frontline service the existing ladder truck T22, a 2014 Pierce model, will be moved into reserve status, thus replacing the existing reserve ladder truck T122, a 2004 American LaFrance model that has now reached its end of service life, and;

WHEREAS, on this date the Board of Directors has received and reviewed a report from the Battalion Chief requesting the Board of Directors declare the existing ladder truck T122, a 2004 American LaFrance model, surplus and authorize donation of ladder truck T122 to the South Bay Regional Fire Training Consortium.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Pebble Beach Community Services District, as follows that:

1. After considering written staff report and verbal testimony discussing the matter of surplus and donation of existing reserve ladder truck T122, a 2004 American LaFrance model, the Board hereby declares ladder truck T122 surplus and authorizes the donation of ladder truck T122 to the South Bay Regional Fire Training Consortium.
2. The General Manager is hereby authorized and directed to sign and deliver all necessary documents in connection with donating ladder truck T122 to the South Bay Regional Fire Training Consortium for and on behalf of the Pebble Beach Community Services District.
